### Counseling and Art Therapy

Art and Design students may choose a 3+3 Bridge to the Master's in Counseling and Art Therapy Program. Through Ursuline's nationally recognized Counseling and Art Therapy master's program, you will be prepared to work in a variety of clinical, educational, medical, and human-service settings as an art therapist.

### Education

The Art and Design program pairs well with Ursuline's new 4+1 bridge to teacher preparation. On this pathway, you would major in Art and Design and take certain Education courses in your four undergraduate years. Then you'd spend a fifth year earning a master's degree in education and preparing for certification.
