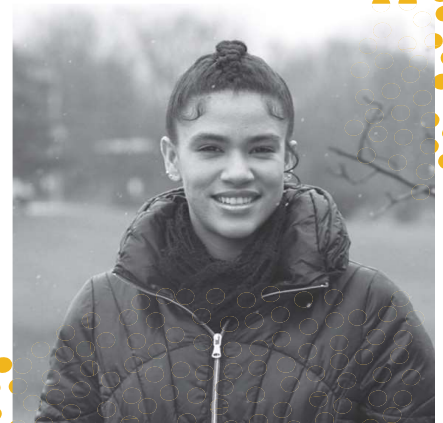
Start with our Core Curriculum and see where it takes you.
