When should you reach out?

- Students with documented learning, psychological or physical disabilities should contact the Disability Specialist to request disability-related accommodations.
- Students who had a 504 plan, IEP or SEGO plan in high school, or accommodations at another institution of higher education may want to contact the Disability Specialist to request accommodations.
- The accommodation process is initiated by the student and is an interactive process between the student, their healthcare provider and the Disability Specialist.
- Students must provide supporting documentation to the Disability Specialist in order to determine eligibility for accommodations.

What supporting documentation is generally needed?

- Students may provide a copy of their most recent 504 plan, IEP, SEGO plan, or ETR from high school or accommodation records from another institution of higher education to be reviewed.
