Undergraduates may significantly decrease the credit hours needed to complete the master's program through the bridge program. In the bridge program, undergraduates complete the 6 credit hours (2 courses) of prerequisites as well as 18 credit hours (6 courses) of required courses that directly count towards the master's degree.
