



Teacher Workshops: Spring 2024 Graduate Credit Information + Assignment

Teacher Workshop participants may receive one graduate workshop credit by completing an additional registration through Ursuline College and completing an additional assignment. The cost to register for the graduate workshop credit is \$140, and students who complete the assignment will receive a pass/fail grade on an official transcript.

Assignment

To receive a graduate workshop credit, teachers must complete all three components listed here:

- 1) Sample lesson plan
- 2) Annotated bibliography
- 3) Reflection essay

Sample Lesson Plan

Based on the content of your workshop, create a lesson plan that you can implement in your classroom, addressing each of the categories below:

- *Goals*: what core information/skills do you hope the students will take away from the experience?
- *Procedures*: share the teacher actions and student actions, outline of the lesson, and the scope of the student assignment if applicable
- *Materials + Scalability*: include materials and tools list, and how it can be altered and scaled to various classrooms depending on available materials/tools

Annotated Bibliography

Develop an annotated bibliography (using whatever citation style you work with) of 3-5 artists who are currently working in the methods and mediums that your workshop focused on. Include a brief abstract about the artist. The abstract should be written with the idea in mind to share these artists' work with students as examples and inspiration.

Reflection Essay

Please reflect on your participation in the Teacher Workshop as well as the development of the annotations and the lesson plan in a 2-3 page (double-spaced) essay. Consider your expectations or goals for participation and how your experiences in the workshop may influence you as an educator and in your personal practice.

Submitting your Work

Final copies of your assignment are due by **Friday, March 15** and must be turned in via email to ce@cia.edu. Ursuline College faculty will receive and grade the reflection and will assign a grade of pass or fail, and teachers will receive a transcript with their grade approximately four weeks after the submission deadline of March 15.
