If you are a working adult who feels called to advocate for others in a meaningful way, the online bachelor's degree program in social work may be for you. Complete your degree and prepare for licensure without quitting your current job. The program offers a collaborative, flexible, and challenging curriculum and a sense of community in each class. Because the program is fully accredited by the Ohio Department of Higher Education and the Council on Social Work Education, graduates have the option of advanced placement in a master's degree program, having earned up to 15 credits of graduate-level work within the BSW program.

Virtual/Live Sessions

As an online social work student, you will meet virtually several times each semester. These meetings serve as an opportunity for discussing course content and allow you to develop relationships with peers. The virtual sessions also allow the instructor to assess what you have learned and to prepare you for entering field placement.

Fieldwork Experience

In addition to the 15-week semesters, students are individually matched with agencies and organizations for fieldwork in their local communities.
