The psychology curriculum will introduce you to the study of human behavior and mental processes. Majors are trained in the Boulder Model, which includes courses in scientific process as well as the practical application of psychological principles. Students can focus their Psychology elective coursework on a variety of pathways. Students can choose electives in Clinical Forensic Psychology, Experimental/Cognitive Psychology, Industrial/Organizational Psychology or School Psychology. Students have the opportunity to blend the strengths of a strong psychology major with psychology electives for various applications in the work place.
