In addition to the nursing courses, students are required to complete two Ursuline Core courses: PH 260 Bioethics and UC 401 Capstone Seminar.

ABSN Application & Admission Requirements

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Part-time students begin their studies in August while full-time students can start in January, May, or August.

To be considered, applicants must have a 2.5 or above from their conferring institution. They also must have passed all of the science prerequisites within two attempts, earning a grade of "C" or higher within the past 7 years.
