In addition to the Social Work courses, students are required to complete the Ursuline Core Curriculum. While your Social Work courses will be taught 100% online, your Core classes will be in-person, providing you with hybrid-style learning. Social Work courses include both synchronous and asynchronous class sessions.



As a graduate of Ursuline's Bachelor's in Social Work (BSW) program, you will be eligible for advanced standing in CSWE accredited Master of Social Work (MSW) programs across the United States, including traditional and online MSW programs.

Social Work Courses Online

What sets our Social Work program apart is that you'll take classes on campus for the first two years, and then for the second two years, you'll take Social Work courses online.

Typically, you'll focus on core courses and electives during your first two years. You may choose to live in a residence hall or compete in athletics. You'll be a traditional undergrad. Junior year, you may continue to live on campus, but the courses in your major will be online. This will include independent work online; collaborative work between students and instructors on-screen; and "town hall" style gatherings with all social work students.
